Grid Reference	Description
Improved Grassland	MG6 <i>Cynosurus cristatus</i> and close cropped sward, combined with abundant sheep droppings, indicate very recent grazing. Some patches of <i>Trifolium</i>
Car Park edges	Stone placed around the periphery with various mosses and tussock grasses, not all identified.
Car Park surface	All tarmac. Mosses such as <i>Brachythecium</i> starting to colonise in the centre of the area.
NH 71085 70095	Remains of a herring gull kill. Predator unknown, but presumed to be fox.
NH 71167 70177	Old fox earth within a small rabbit warren. 8 holes, 5 remain open, 3 have collapsed. Rabbit droppings abundant, searched for badger evidence but none recorded
NH 71126 70185	Fox earth, presumed to be occupied based on smell. Rabbit droppings abundant.
NH 71062 70191	Fox feeding signs and a few red mammal hairs presumed to be fox.
NH 71029 70136	More fox feeding signs
